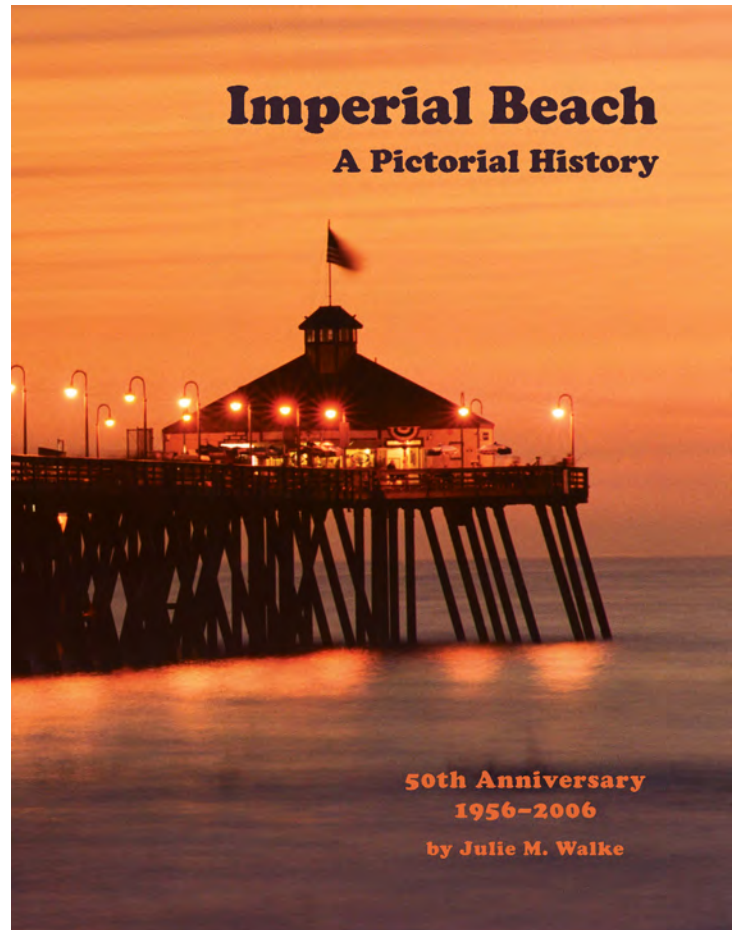


Imperial Beach, A Pictorial History, **by author Julie Walke** **is again available for purchase.**
